Specified door constructions including components and hardware that reduces the overall risk of providing a ligature can be difficult to find, which is why we will support you in selecting the parts you need for your doorset.

The Anti-Ligature Serving Hatch can be fitted into the door leaf, allowing for goods such as food and drink to be passed through the aperture without opening the door. This offers security for both the client and staff, while providing a ligature-free surface on the side of the client that reduces the risk of harm.

OPERATION

The serving hatch may be opened from the outside via a key or single-handed thumbturn, retracting the bolting system and enabling the hatch to be opened. The hatch may then be closed and locked using the same method. The thumbturn may be 'over locked' using an optional square key preventing unauthorised use of the hatch.
