

STORE DOOR

The STORES ISSUE doorset has been designed to provide the facility for controlled and secure issue of goods such as armaments and ammunition. They have been successfully installed in facilities across the United Kingdom and overseas for a number of years providing the requisite levels of safety and security in the distribution of secure items.

DETAILS

APPLICATION - Stores Issue doorsets are typically installed in combination with an appropriate secure entrance door that provides controlled access to the building, but not the stores.

CONFIGURATION - Stores Issue doorsets can be provided inward or outward opening, as either a single leaf with an in-built hinged serving hatch, or a stable type door with a shelf or counter to the lower leaf.

FINISHES - Stores Issue doorsets can be supplied primed, spray finished, or powder coated to any BS or RAL colour.

LOCKING - Doors are generally secured with either a high security hookbolt lock, or security deadlock with key entry both sides. Hatches and stable leaves are secured from the inside only with Surelock TD barrel bolts.

SPECIFICATION

Door frames to be 100mmx50mm box section.

Door leaf to be 50mm x 50mm 6mm angles.

Mesh to be 2089 Raised Expamet Doors to be powder coat finish to our standard range Barrel bolts are S3TD supplied and fitted.

Hatch Padlock to be supplied by others on site.

Doors to be fitted with a Chubb 3G110 Lock.
